As requested please find on the enclosed CD my suggestions for the PIF web site phase 1. This letter is an update to my attached e-mail entitled "PIF website holding page - 2nd draft" sent 30th July 2007 16:37. Copies of this letter and the e-mail are also on the enclosed CD as PDF files.

About the CD.

To start viewing the web site you will need to use your browser (Internet Explorer?) to open the file called *index.html*. You will then be able to click on the links to all the other pages.

As this is a web site on a CD the links in the translation menu, "*About PIF in other languages*", will not work as expected by opening new windows to automatically translate pages from UK English to other languages. The links in the translation menu for the version of this web site in my private demo web space at <http://www.tpn4portsmouth.info/wip/pif2/index.html> do work as expected.

Before going live.

Before going live with this web site, I would suggest that the PIF Steering Group read every page.

I also suggest that they do the following.

1. Formally contact each of the organisations mentioned on the "*Who supports PIF?*" page (*pif_supporters.html*) to obtain permission to use their logotypes. I have taken it 'as read' that Wessex Jamaat, the Anglican Diocese of Portsmouth, and Interfusion, have already given their permission. Obviously, I do not have to get permission to use the logotype for Nick Bryant Advanced & Ethical Marketing & Design.

2. Obtain the permission, logotypes, and web site link addresses for the appropriate Baha'i, Buddhist, Hindu, Jewish, and Sikh faith groups that support PIF. Presumably the members of the PIF Steering Group that represent these faith groups will know who to contact in order to do this.

3. Replace my name and photograph on the “*Why join PIF?*” page (*join_pif.html*) with someone important, well known, and ‘media friendly’, who is not associated by most people with a particular faith. Replacements that readily spring to mind are Nelson Mandela, Kofi Annan, or Sir Bob Geldof (for secular support with young people and ‘thirty something’s).
